70. Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 8 December 2022, previously circulated, were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chair.

72. Public Forum

73. Events Periodic Report

73.1. The Committee received a report, previously circulated, which contained an update, on the plans for 2023 to 2024 events programme. Regarding the Screen On The Green event, it was noted that additional local policing would be requested but that this was not specifically for the public conveniences. It was anticipated that the Community Wardens would be in attendance. It was asked whether bunting had been organised for the Coronation and whether a window competition could be organised in a similar way to the Christmas one for shop keepers. The Town Clerk confirmed that bunting would be festooning the High Street and would refer the other matter to the Policy and Finance Committee.

It was Resolved that:

- 1. The recommended prize money to the winner and runner up at the Pancake Olympics event, should no further sponsorship be secured, at the cost of £175.00 be approved.
- 2. The hiring of a Flight Display Director for the Armed Forces Day event at a cost of £2,276.00 be approved.
- 3. The proposed date for the Sandcastle Competition be approved.
- 4. The provision of an inflatable screen at the Screen on the Green event be approved.
- 5. The contents of the report be noted.

74.1. Members received a report, previously circulated, which highlighted work being undertaken by the Community Resources Officer to progress the projects and initiatives within the remit of this Committee. In noting that the Youth Services Contract would be discussed at the next meeting, members asked for details of the current contract to be circulated
